Hickey Center (LRS) Universal Pre-K	Promotes school readiness of children from zero to age five from low-income families by enhancing their cognitive, social, and emotional development. Mental Health Outpatient Treat- ment & Rehabilitative Services Counseling Centers	Provide evidence based, trauma-informed individual and family therapy to help children manage emotional and behavioral difficulties in their local community.	Bronx, Dutchess, Sullivan, Ulster	
Trauma Recovery Center	Serves as a community hub to support victims of violent crime, with clear referral pathways from local hospitals, legal defense services, law enforcement, and other community pathways.	Bronx	
School Based Programs Astor Learning Center (ALC)	Provides services to students ages 5 through 14 who are experiencing emotional and educational challenges. Students reside at home while attending a more structured educational program. All students receive support to help them return successfully to their local districts. Day Treatment	Provides long-term clinical treatment and education to youth with serious behavioral difficulties in a school setting.	Dutchess, Ulster

Home & Community Based Programs Adolescent Partial Hospitalization	Provides short-term clinical services to adolescents in danger of needing a higher level of care or transitioning from a higher level of care.	Dutchess, Ulster, Orange, Rockland	
Care Management	Provides care coordination to Health Home eligible children. A care manager links, supports, and oversees access to services/systems a child and family may need to improve overall health. Enhanced Coordinated Children's Services Initiative (ECCSI)	A multi-agency process that seeks to prevent out-of-home placement and coordinate services to meet the family's complex needs in Dutchess County.	Dutchess	
Family Therapy & Support Services	Services for youth with behavioral issues, including Juvenile Delinquent (JD) and Persons in Need of Supervision (PINS).	Orange	
High Fidelity Wrap Around	Care coordination to offer children & adolescents a positive outcome. The process involves intensive, individualized planning and managing for ages 12-21 with serious emotional, or behavioral concerns.	Bronx, Dutchess, Orange, Ulster, Columbia	
Home Based Crisis Intervention (HBCI)	Provides short-term crisis support and treatment for children and their families to avoid a higher level of care.	Dutchess, Ulster

Probation Based Services & Juvenile Risk Intervention	Probation Based Services is a family therapy program for children involved with Dutchess County's Dept of Probation & Community Corrections.	Dutchess
